Do you love botanical and wildlife art and want to learn to draw from natures?

Have fun learning whilst being part of a small friendly group. You will work at your own pace

## WHAT YOU WILL LEARN.

We will be exploring ways to bring nature alive by leaning to draw and paint directly from a specimen (preferably) and/or photographs.

We will be using graphite, coloured pencil and/or water colour paints

We will be focussing on drawing, composition and to explore the colour wheel and experimenting with watercolour techniques.



## START-UP MATERIALS LIST.

For the first lesson please bring a plant, shell, seed pod, leaf or any reference picture or photo that you may wish to draw from.

- A range of graphite pencils H, HB, 2H, 2B (Staedtler Mars Lumograph preferred.
- Drawing Board larger than A3 size
- White plastic Eraser and Kneadable Eraser.
- Pencil Sharpener or Sharpening device.

- Watercolour paper (hot pressed, 300gsm) A3 Arches preferable
- · Watercolour paints OR a selection of coloured pencils
