This course is mainly for beginners but it is also useful to those who want to brush up on and develop their practice further.

2 medium sized canvas boards
small sketch book
only odourless solvent may be used in this class
jar with lid for solvent
palette for mixing - paper palettes are great
square hog bristle brushes No 4,6,8,10
rags
metal palette knife
colours, titanium white - large tube, raw sienna, yellow ochre, raw umber, ultramarine blue, cobalt blue, alizarine crimson, cadmium red mid, cadmium yellow mid
Student quality paints are recommended particularly for the cadmium and cobalt colours as these are very expensive in artist quality.
I recommend Winton, Pebeo and Sennelier student quality.
